## *A Word From Your Director of Missions Dr. Danny L. Morris*



Our Association income support from churches the first quarter of last year was \$51,456.10. The Association church giving support first quarter this year is \$52,072.65.

Our income for January was \$18,563.68 above the average monthly \$13,469.84. January is usually higher partly because churches giving percentage of their undesignated income often receive more during December thus increasing their check to the Association in January. Also, any church increasing the budget giving to the Association is normally reflected in this first month of the New Year. We are grateful for the support.

Our income flow indicates that our realistic monthly budget should project to be around \$13,500 monthly or \$162,000 for the year. That remains an adjustment to the approximately 25% or approximately \$2,500 monthly reduction in income we had in the years prior to last year.

Our October Annual Association meeting affirmed the recommendation of the Executive Committee and a working Strategy Planning Committee to sell the Alexander Street building and move our offices to 301 S. Collins Street, Suite 104. The Strategy Planning Committee listed it with a realtor and provided a church usage lease to a non-denominational church in January, 2011. The property remains for sale; however, it has a \$2000 a month income and a reduction of expenses related to utilities, custodial, lawn care, and daily maintenance. That expense reduction is approximately \$500. We are thankful for God's guidance in the process. This enabled us to move into the new offices and increase our services while reducing our expenses to our undesignated church mission giving to the Association. We have worked hard to make the new office suite a good working resource center for our Association. You are welcome to come by and visit anytime. Our next Executive Committee meeting, March 15, at 10:00 a.m., will include an open house.

This will be a great time to see your facility. The new advantage includes having the Truth Christian Store and it's Event Center in the building with us. That gives an added advantage and a great ministry to serve our church leadership. The Truth Christian Store has a Ministers' Fellowship to the larger community on the 3<sup>rd</sup> Thursday of each month. You are welcome to come by and share food, fellowship, and possibly get a gift or discounts on your Christian materials.

The Strawberry Festival is close at hand and we are excited about our SOS Evangelism booth. Since starting the booth approximately 3000 people have come to Christ. We are grateful for the SOS ministry and for all who participate in this ministry. We are very excited to see what God does this year.

As we start setting up the booth we are asking for a love donation from each church so that we will be able to cover the cost of the booth this year and any extra revenue will be provided as a love offering to SOS and to cover some advance expenses for next year.

We also have the Campers on Mission with us again this year. They will be setting up at Liberty Baptist Church. Any supplies you collect can be taken to Northside Baptist Church Monday - Thursday 8:30 to 4:30.

Liberty Baptist Church is also partnering with Campers on Mission to serve hot food to those who are in need. There will be a tent set up at the church for this purpose. If any church would like to donate any food for this ministry please contact Pastor Mike Fredette at the church office.
